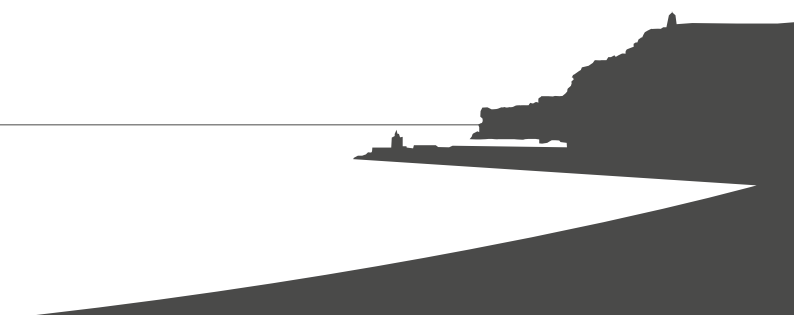

Fairway Chenin Blanc

South Africa

Lemon and lime aromas are abundant. A clean, lively wine with nuances of nutmeg and cloves.

Red Wines

Coastal Reserve Merlot

La Mancha, Spain

The dry summer heat of Spain beautifully ripens the grapes and concentrates the rich plum and red fruit flavours. The wine's supple structure is complimented by a hint of liquorice and warm vanilla spice.

7 Fires Malbec

Uco Valley, Argentina

Ruby-red wine displaying a fresh and fruity nose, enhanced by hints of plum, black berries and a touch of vanilla; fresh fruit flavours, supported by sweet and round tannins.

Blass Shiraz

South Australia

Bright, juicy aromas of plum, redcurrant and red berries with subtle hints of vanilla oak. Medium-bodied, soft and easy drinking wine with plenty of juicy red fruit flavour.

Monologo Rioja Crianza

Rioja, Spain

Redcurrant, sloes and cherries, coupled with notes of vanilla, pepper, toast, tobacco leaves and a light smokiness from its time in barrel.

Domaine Chanson Fleurie

Burgundy, France

Bright ruby colour with intense aromas of ripe cherries. The wine is well balanced with beautifully focussed fruit and a long aftertaste, culminating in spicy nuances.

White Wines

Castello di Gabbiano Pinot Grigio

£21.00

Veneto, Italy

Floral notes caress the nose, with nuances of pear and honeydew melon. Citrus flavours are evident on the palate, alongside crunchy green apple and pear. This wine finds an excellent harmony of fruit and acid, with a slightly nutty almond finish.

Coastal Reserve Sauvignon Blanc

South West, France

A speciality of south west France, this dry white wine is vibrant and elegant. Typical of Sauvignon Blanc this wine has a fresh grassy character with punchy tropical fruit flavours.

Blass Chardonnay

£23.00

South Australia

Lifted notes of pear-skin and melon with hints of citrus. Flavourful notes of stonefruits ensure the palate is well rounded with a rich, balanced finish.

Matua Sauvignon Blanc

£31.50

Marlborough, New Zealand

Founded in 1974, Matua was the first New Zealand winery to produce Sauvignon Blanc and takes its name from a Maori word meaning Head of the Family. Deliciously pure, bursting with citrus, grapefruit and a hint of basil. The palate is vibrant and concentrated with blackcurrant leaf, nettle and green melon.

Josselin Chablis

Burgundy, France

This Chablis is pale gold in colour. It has an intense freshness typical of the area, with ripe white fruit and white blossom aromas. On the palate, its minerality gives a lingering finish and wonderfully distinct character.

Produced in the province of Pavia where the long slow ripening season helps create wines of complexity and finesse. Juicy red berry flavours, Galia melon and subtle honeysuckle lead to a clean finish with a hint of white pepper.



Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Italia Prosecco DOC

Veneto, Italy

Fruity flavours of apple, melon and pear mingle with a gently floral note. The mousse is fine, frothy and persistent.

Ayala Brut Majeur Champagne

Champagne, France

The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus, florals and white fruits. The style is one of modernity, exemplified by their grower relationships and the use of stainless steel in the production of their Chardonnay led wines.

Ayala Rosé Majeur Champagne

Champagne, France

The nose displays aromas of strawberries, raspberries and morello cherries together with nuances of spice. Light, fresh and well-balanced palate with flavours of red gooseberry and raspberry lingering on the finish.

Bollinger Special Cuvée

Champagne, France

The nose is aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spices. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches burst on the palate. Brioche and walnut linger on the finish. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity.
